

2018 Municipal Engineers Association Bursary Program

The Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) is proud to advise that as part of its 2018 Bursary Program, five \$1,500 bursaries will be awarded to the children and dependents of municipal employees.

These bursaries are available for those who are presently in high school and entering university engineering programs this fall to become engineers.

Application submissions closed earlier this past spring, and the MEA Bursary Selection Committee reviewed and evaluated applications in order to make a recommendation to the Executive Committee for approval. The selection is made through a consideration of the completeness of the application, the quality of the introductory message of submission, the interest expressed to become an engineer, need for the bursary, personal references of character, and the ability to prepare a paper on an engineering topic.

As a result of the consideration of these applications, the Committee recommended the following students receive an MEA Bursary - the Executive Committee approved the bursary awards at its recent June 2018 Board Meeting:
