Bold and innovative planning with an eye to the future is needed.

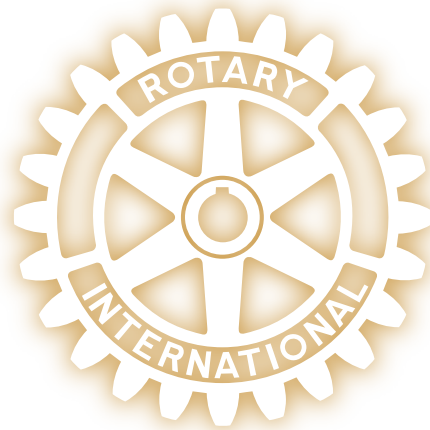
New technologies, some developed during the pandemic, are changing the way people can work. Recent legislation is affecting modes of transportation and production of energy.

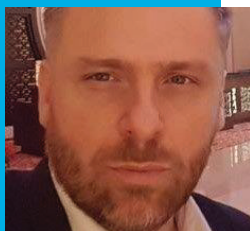
Tim Hudak, CEO of Ontario Real Estate Assoc.
