

Canada's Active Transportation Trend

Bicycle Usage

 Number of Canadians cycling to work increased by 41% from 2006 to 2016, with further growth noted during the COVID-19 pandemic (Statistics Canada)

Walking Trends

 A 2021 report by the Canadian Institute for Health Information indicated that approximately 13% of Canadians walk as their primary mode of transportation for short trips


Government Initiatives

 In 2021 the Government of Canada announced a commitment of \$400 million over five years to enhance cycling and pedestrian infrastructure as part of its Active Transportation Fund

Public Support

 A survey by the Canadian urban Transit Association found that 71% of Canadians support expanding bike lanes and pedestrian pathways in urban areas


What is Active Transportation?




























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Options Review

Small Budget Community Improvement Projects

- Pavement Marking and Signage Improvements
- Site Furniture and/or Green Infrastructure

Medium Budget Infrastructure Renewal Projects

- Paved Shoulders (Painted/Buffer Bike Lanes)
- Pavement Marking and Signage Improvements

Large Budget Infrastructure Upgrade Projects

- Dedicated and Separated Pedestrian and Cycling Facilities
- Protected Intersections
- Vertical Deflection Measures
- Horizontal Deflection Measures
