#### **MEMBERSHIP**

- Membership growth has stabilized somewhat over last 12 months.
  - □ 1,200 1,230 members over last 12 months
    - > MEA has members in over 100 municipalities representing nearly 90% of Ontario's population.
    - > 23 corporate memberships (min. 11 members) representing approx. 1040 members
    - > Approx. 180 non-corporate (individual) memberships

#### **ADMIN AGREEMENT WITH GR**

- MEA relies on Good Roads for bookkeeping and general membership administration
- New agreement was finalized with GR in September 2024
  - Will run for up to 5 years
  - Looking for ways to reduce reliance on GR for general membership administration

#### **EMPLOYMENT ADS**

- ▶ Platform of choice for municipalities, and other employers to advertise engineering related opportunities
- Approx. 29,000 visits per year to MEA's "Careers" page
- ► In the fiscal year ending Aug. 31, 2023, over 260 employment ads were placed on MEA website
  - ► Translates to about \$140,000 in revenue
- ► MEA has 514 weekly subscribers who receive a weekly email notice to view current employment opportunities.
- Employment Ads is currently the MEA's largest revenue generating enterprise (excluding Conference).

#### **MCEA**

- MCEA Amendment approved March of 2023
  - MCEA Document posted to ERO. Free for everyone.
- ► New MCEA User Guide published September 2023
  - Over 120 hard copy user guides have been sold.
  - Digital subscription on hold
  - Reconcile with future new regulation (MPAP)
- Municipal Project Assessment Process (MPAP)
  - Presentation by Reg Russwurm yesterday
  - Waiting on direction from MECP on when MPAP may be implemented
  - □ When/if implanted, MEA will be publishing new version of User Guide
  - □ Until MPAP is implemented, MCEA still applies!


#### MCEA USER GUIDE

#### **OPS - ADMINISTRATION**

- OPS Administration now includes 3 committee coordinators
  - Amanda Rodek MTO
  - Steven Forte MTO
  - Rishabh Sharma MEA
- MOU with MTO re: sharing the costs for Rishabh
- ▶ OPS Committee Meetings are a combination of virtual and in-person
  - □ Targeting 2 in-person meetings per year
  - Option to have meetings during Good Roads + MEA Conference

#### **OPS - TRAINING**

- ▶ MEA offered two (2) OPS 101 Course Webinars in 2024
  - □ 128 students participated
- ► Inaugural OPS 201 Course Webinar in October 2024
  - 59 students participate
- ► MEA will be providing new "OPS General Course" as part of the 2025 Roads School at the University of Guelph.
  - 2.5 day in-person course (including exam)
  - □ Broader appeal at Roads School to include operations front line staff, supervisors, etc. – but also still appropriate for engineering staff

#### **FUTURE NEW TRAINING**

- MEA is looking to expand its training program.
- First additional course in the works is Excess Soils.
  - ► Targeting Autumn 2025 launch

- Reviewing potential partners in delivering training.
- Review MEA's MIT Certification

#### **ANNUAL CONFERENCE**

- The MEA Conference continues to grow!
  - Any suggestions to improve the conference?
- 2024: Registrations and tradeshow established new records!
- Future conference locations will need to be restricted to those municipalities that have sufficient conference/hotel facilities
  - Convention Space Requirements:
    - ▶ Minimum 12,000 square feet main hall for meals/tradeshow
    - > 2 rooms for concurrent technical sessions (130-person seating, theatre style)
  - Hotel Space Requirements:
    - ▶ 200 250 hotel rooms per day
- 2025 Conference will be held in London at RBC Place Convention Centre + DoubleTree Hotel
- ► 2026 Location under review
- ▶ 2027 Toronto

# MEA/ACEC-Ontario STD ENG'G AGREEMENT

- ► MEA has been working with ACEC-Ontario to streamline and update the language in the current agreement
- New version is ready and loaded to MEA website
