Position Overview: Oversee the Town's municipal water supply and distribution systems, wastewater treatment and collection systems, stormwater management infrastructure, and environmental services programs.

Provide leadership, strategic oversight, and operational management for the division, including administration, regulatory compliance, long-term infrastructure planning, and coordination with the Town's operating authority under agreement.

- P.Eng. and/or PMP certification considered an asset.
