You will also have leadership responsibilities for the civil design group within HDR's multi-disciplinary ASMEC business class including: supervision of technical work performed by team members, quality reviews, and routine workload planning for the civil group. These group leadership responsibilities may also extend to encompass coordination of supplementary staff who may be called upon to contribute to specific projects.

Project types have typically tended towards transportation-related facilities, such as transit lines and stations, however work on other project types and market sectors within the scope of ASMEC's technical capabilities will also be required.
