- provide leadership, guidance and support for all staff in the division;
- oversee the preparation and administration of all operating and capital budgets within the portfolio;
- lead negotiation and determination of Town cost-sharing related to infrastructure upgrades through development applications such as input to relevant sections of the Development Charge By-Law, Engineering Fees Development Application designs and construction;
- provide direction of the capital works engineering design program for all roadrelated municipal infrastructure including expertise for all external consulting engineering studies;
- oversee the management of the capital construction programs including construction of new, replacement and significant maintenance work for asset categories such as roads, bridges and culverts;
- oversee development engineering including providing direction in the detailed engineering review, approvals on all applications as well as subdivision and drainage submissions;
- provide leadership and direction for all Town water resource and stormwater management programs including strategic communication with external consultants, engineering design and technical expertise as well as assisting in the development of applicable software program(s);

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- supervise and support the recruitment, training, development, attendance, performance and goals of staff;
- oversee the development and maintenance of all policies and procedures for the division;
- develop short and long term strategies and/or delivery plans for all related systems to ensure long term efficient operation while minimizing service interruptions and maintaining community engagement;
- be responsible for project implementation, project management and managing project teams;
- prepare and make recommendations on the prioritization of capital needs;
- investigate opportunities for external capital program funding sources, oversee the preparation of external funding and grant applications and negotiate funding partnerships for projects with other agencies;
- responding and/or reporting to Council on various complex matters;
- represent the Town at public meetings and/or legal proceedings; and,
- perform other job-related duties and responsibilities as assigned.
