- Management of the Environmental Services Department's Infrastructure Capital Delivery Group
- Manages capital projects ranging from condition assessment, studies design, and construction projects, of the following assets: water, wastewater, stormwater assets.
- Manages condition inspection programs for: CCTV inspection of sanitary/ storm sewers, storm / sanitary pump stations
- Conducts appropriate studies including Environmental Assessments, prepare Request for Proposals and Request for Tender, reviews / approves design drawings, oversees contract administration / inspection activities, completes project closeout activities
- Ensures financial, time, and risk management strategies are applied while manages the Environmental Services Capital program.
- Manages and liaises with consultants, contractors and external agencies
- Provides directions to staff and leads the project team to complete the department's annual Capital Works Program.
