Location

This position is located at Regional Headquarters in Whitby, Ontario.

Project Manager - Stormwater Management

This position is responsible to coordinate and lead the delivery of stormwater management services for the Region's Transportation Infrastructure group and to use this platform to help create and manage the regions flood related datasets from a risk perspective as well as future climate probability shifts. This position will also provide inputs into the Regions asset management plans by means of providing flood risk mitigation and resilience strategies, while working closely with other sections of the Region to best manage the Regional Road system that balances mobility requirements with the needs of the Regional community. Reporting to the Manager of Transportation Infrastructure, the incumbent will:

- Oversee the technical review and commenting of engineering submissions, Stormwater Management reports, Flood Risk strategies, drainage related inventory, etc. which have an impact on the Regional road system to preserve the functional integrity of the present and future road network; provide technically consistent designs and comments; and to deliver timely, well engineered plans
- Identify and secure funding for Regional road, structures and storm improvements and programs to ensure proposals, projects and programs are financially feasible; and to safeguard the financial and material assets of the Regional Corporation
- Supervise and guide staff team to ensure the most effective and cost-efficient use of staff resources; promote staff responsibility, empowerment and awareness; and to implement corporate, departmental, and branch directives in a consistent manner
- Initiate, prepare and deliver plans and proposals for more complex transportation projects and plans pertaining to the Regional road system to develop a transportation system which complies with and follows the intent of Regional policies, initiatives and industry guidelines; and to address transportation system needs in terms of the system vision
- Coordinate, initiate and take a lead role in transportation issues involving multiple divisions, departments and external agencies to maintain an integrated transportation system which addresses Regional concerns pertaining to policy and visioning; to provide visible interactive Regional representation; and to facilitate and lead processes which affect Regional policy and direction
- Represent the Regional Corporation to satisfy legislated requirements and expectations; to maintain and promote the Regional image; and to maintain professional relations and education
- Work in accordance with the provisions of applicable health and safety legislation and all corporate/departmental policies and procedures related to occupational health and safety

The successful applicant will possess:

- A post-secondary degree in Civil Engineering or in a related discipline
- Licensed as a Professional Engineer (P. Eng.) with the Professional Engineers of Ontario
- Extensive experience in a design, operations and planning environment; some of which was in a supervisory role
- Knowledge of stormwater management, transportation engineering and design, climate change mitigation and adaptation strategies, value engineering, hydraulic analysis, and project management
- Proficient in the use of Microsoft Office software
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills as well as project management skills
