



## Indigenous History

Paleo Period, retreat of the ice sheets brought hunters here following game - 11,000 years ago.

Archaic Period, temperature increases and forest growth provides more resources and human activity here - 9,000 years ago

Woodland Period, transition to hunting and gathering and growing of crops, use of the local chert for tools and local clay for pottery, the land is transformed by human hands - 3,000 years ago

Historic Period, when European contact transformed trading and indigenous communities - 400 years ago




